O come, all ye faithful, joyful and triumphant! O come ye, O come ye, to Bethlehem Come and behold Him Born the King of Angels





Away in a manger No crib for a bed The little Lord Jesus Laid down His sweet head


The stars in the bright sky Looked down where He lay The little Lord Jesus Asleep on the hay

Bless all the dear children In Thy tender care And fit us for heaven To live with Thee there




Santa Claus is coming to Town

You better watch out, you better not cry You better not pout, I'm telling you why Santa Claus is coming Santa Claus is coming Santa Claus is coming to town!




Jingle Bell Rock



All of the other reindeer Used to laugh and call him names They never let poor Rudolph Join in any reindeer games


Then one foggy Christmas Eve Santa came to say "Rudolph, with your nose so bright Won't you guide my sleigh tonight?"


Merry Christmas Everybody


