

## FAIRTRADE FIGHTS POVERTY AND IMPROVES LIVES THROUGH TRADE

### *This is how ...*

**Fairtrade** guarantees farmers and producers in marginalised societies in the developing world a fair and stable price for their produce.

**Fairtrade** provides an additional premium, paid to producer organisations, to enable whole community projects such as training, school-building, sanitation and healthcare programmes.

**Fairtrade** encourages environmental awareness and sustainable methods of production.

**Fairtrade** requires producer organisations to offer safe working conditions and prohibits exploitative child labour.

**Fairtrade** enables producers in marginalised societies to tackle trade injustice caused by unfair tariffs and subsidies, so that they can reach international markets.

**Fairtrade** provides disadvantaged producers with a regular income so that they can send their children to school, giving the next generation a chance to avoid poverty.

The **FAIRTRADE** Mark is a registered certification label for products sourced from producers in developing countries. Products described as Fairtrade (one word) carry the **FAIRTRADE** Mark and meet international Fairtrade standards set by Fairtrade International.

Products described as fair trade or fairly traded (two words) do not carry the **FAIRTRADE** mark but are traded in line with the work of the wider movement of organisations such as the World FairTrade Organisation (WFTO) and the British Association for Fair Trade Shops (BAFTS).

Offers a selection of Fairtrade hot chocolate drinks, decaffeinated coffee and sugar.

Offers Fairtrade hot chocolate, specialist and decaffeinated teas.

Offers Fairtrade tea, coffee, bananas.
