Proposed by Cllr. Cadd, seconded by Cllr. Isham and AGREED to suspend the Standing Order re voting by show of hands to enable a secret ballot to take place.

Members voted; as the result did not give an overall majority for any candidate, the one with fewest votes (Mr. Dillow) was excluded and Members voted again, excluding in turn Mrs. Takuma, and then Mr. Lehmann. Mr. Hirons was therefore declared the co-opted candidate, signed the Declaration and took his place at the table.

The other candidates left the meeting.
