#### 3208 BUCKINGHAM PLAN - CLLR. WHYTE

Proposed by Cllr. Whyte, seconded by Cllr. Isham, and **AGREED** that the Buckingham Plan as per the text circulated with the Council agenda on 27<sup>th</sup> October 2008 be formally submitted to Aylesbury Vale District Council and Bucks. County Council for consultation with a response date prior to 12<sup>th</sup> January 2009; any amendments to be agreed by the Council before the final document is submitted as part of the LDF documentation.

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### 3210 TO DISCUSS AND AGREE A BUDGET FOR OFFICE FURNITURE AND COMPUTER FOR THE ACCOUNTS ASSISTANT - CLLR. STUCHBURY

Members discussed at length the requirements of the office staff for a convenient working environment. It was noted that the new members of staff would need to call on the experience of existing staff and this was not practical in separate offices. It was agreed to ask F & A to discuss this and bring a recommendation to the Council.

Proposed by Cllr. Try, seconded by Cllr. P. Collins, that this Council purchases a computer and office equipment for use by the Accounts Assistant up to a budget of £1500.

An amendment was proposed by Cllr. Whyte, seconded by Cllr. Newell, that the budget limit should be £1250; this was **AGREED** by 11 votes to 1 with Cllr. Isham abstaining.

Proposed by Cllr. Whyte, seconded by Cllr. Stevens, and **AGREED** by 11 votes to 0 that this Council seeks a change of use on Cemetery Lodge from Residential to Office; Cllr. Isham abstained.

It was **AGREED** that the Finance and Administration Committee would look at the feasibility and work required to convert the Cemetery Lodge from a residence to an office.
