It was **AGREED** to create a heading entitled Project Contingency – Staff to allow the new Town Clerk to appoint a Project Manager for the extension and/or a Green Spaces Manager for the parks if necessary.

Account 4028 Councillors Mileage: Proposed by Cllr. Stuchbury, seconded but Cllr. Mahi, that the amount be £500. Amendment proposed by Cllr. Smith, seconded by Cllr. Collins, that the amount be £750 was defeated by 7 votes to 8. The original proposition was then **AGREED** by 9 votes to 6.

Account 4070 Grants – Section 137: Declarations of interest as per Finance and Administration Minute number 481.

Account 4077 Old Gaol Funding: Cllr. Whyte and Cllr. Smith declared a personal interest as Trustees.

131 Major Projects – Account Film Place: Proposed by Cllr. Collins, seconded by Cllr. Newell, and **AGREED** by 12 votes to 0 to give the Film Place a grant of £1,000 per year for 3 years and to remove the £1,000 grant to the Film Place under Account 4070 Grants.

Members wished it to be noted that Account 406/4025 Fees & Professional Charges would be a one off cost for the next year and would pay for the architect, quantity surveyor, structural engineer, services engineer, the CDM coordinator, the below ground drainage design, the energy assessment calculation and all the legal costs including; change of lease, change of right of access, building insurance and building regulation compliance.

407 Major Building works – PWLB extension/interest: Members were informed by the Deputy Town Clerk that this total also included the existing loan for Cemetery Lodge as it was unclear if we would have to amalgamate the two loans.

Cllr. Stuchbury left the meeting at this point

It was **AGREED** by 12 votes to 1 - Cllr. Lehmann wished for his objection to be recorded – to precept the figure of £40,000.

Cllr. Stuchbury returned to the meeting.

Account 4086 Youth Centre Cllrs. Lehmann and Isham declared prejudicial interests.

Cllr. Lehman left the meeting during discussion on Account 4500 Contingencies and returned during discussions on Account 4057 War Memorial.

Amounts to be ring-fenced in the Environment & Property Committee budget to be agreed by the Chairman of the E&P Committee and the Clerk.

Account 4050 Materials it was **AGREED** to change the title of this account to Preliminaries.

406 Cemetery Lodge – Upgrading Lighting and Electrics – Proposed by Cllr. Smith, seconded by Cllr. Collins, that the amount be £0. Amendment proposed by Cllr. Cadd, seconded by Cllr. Stuchbury, that the amount be £5,000 was tied at 7 votes to 7. A re-vote was called where the amendment was defeated by 7 votes to 9. The original proposition for the amount of £0 was then **AGREED** by 9 votes to 8 with the Chairman using his casting vote.

Cllrs. Bloomfield and Lehmann left the meeting after the above discussion and vote and returned after the next item Change of Use.

Account 4120 BTCV Grant Payment: Proposed by Cllr. Lehmann, seconded by Cllr. Desorgher, that the amount be £1,000 was defeated by 5 votes to 8, the figure of £2,000 was then **AGREED.**

Account 4205 Christmas Parade: Proposed by Cllr. Lehmann that the amount be £2,625; Cllr. Cadd, seconded by Cllr. Loftus, proposed by that the amount be £3,125; a further amendment proposed by Cllr. Whyte, seconded by Cllr. Collins, of £3,000 was **AGREED** by 12 votes to 1.

4215: Cllr. Try declared a prejudicial interest in this budget item.

Account 4228 Entertainments: Proposed by Cllr. Collins, seconded by Cllr. Hirons, that the amount be £0 was **REJECTED** by 4 votes to 8. The figure of £975 was then **AGREED**.

Account 4260 Twinning: Cllr. Mordue declared a personal interest, remaining in the chair but taking no part in the discussion.

4083 Capital Reserve: Cllr. Collins explained that in normal circumstances that an amount of approximately 3 months running costs is kept in the Capital Reserve; however, as this is an exceptional year with a major building project, then the Council might wish to reduce the amount in Capital Reserve.

Proposed by Cllr. Collins, seconded by Cllr. Hirons, that the amount be £20,000 was **REJECTED** by 5 votes to 8.

Proposed by Cllr. Smith, seconded by Cllr. Loftus, that the amount be £45,000 was **AGREED** by 9 votes to 5.

Proposed by Cllr. Lehmann, seconded by Cllr. Stuchbury, and **REJECTED** by 4 votes to 11 that the Council review the major budgets again to make any necessary changes.

TO PASS A RESOLUTION AGREEING THE PRECEPT REQUEST AMOUNT FOR 2009/2010 AS PER THE ABOVE DISCUSSIONS

Proposed by Cllr. Mordue, seconded by Cllr. Collins, that Buckingham Town Council would set a precept of £526,944.00 which equates to £121.54 for a band D property.

Cllr. Lehmann and 3 other Councillors under Standing Order number 13a called for a recorded vote on the motion.

For a precept of £526,944:

Cllr. Mordue, Cllr. Cadd, Cllr. Smith, Cllr. Hirons, Cllr. Mahi, Cllr. Whyte, Cllr. Try, Cllr. Bloomfield, Cllr. Collins, Cllr. Isham and Cllr. Loftus.

Against a precept of £526,944:

Cllr. Mrs Stevens, Cllr. Ms. Newell, Cllr. Mrs Desorgher, Cllr. Stuchbury and Cllr. Lehmann.

It was therefore **RESOLVED** that Buckingham Town Council sets a precept of £526,944.
