Propose to write to the Cabinet Member for Safeguarding - Children & Young People to ascertain the future of the Buckingham Youth Centre both in terms of service and the building.

As a Town Council Representative on the board of trustees at Buckingham Youth Centre it has come to light that Jim Whatmore the only full time youth worker at Buckingham Youth Centre will be made redundant from the 31<sup>st</sup> of March 2011. Over the last 10 years Buckingham Town Council has invested in the Youth Centre, financing a number of improvements to the building. Currently Mr. Whatmore as part of his position is acting as the bursar for the centre, taking bookings and generating revenue. It is important that he will be replaced in April 2011. If he is not it could mean the end for the Youth Centre and youth provision in the town. Buckingham Town Council due to its investment has a vested interest in the continuation of the service and how the building will be disposed of should the worst happen. Currently there is no further information available to staff or trustees.
