Mr. Dix reports: The formal request for a modelling contribution is now unlikely to be forthcoming. Mr. Barton provided the office with a draft of the potential letter so that the

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accuracy of explanation was agreed. However, information about the future costs of individual 'runs' of the model was omitted in earlier discussion and only came to light in this letter. Runs were explained as costing a further £2000 each, for which BTC might receive a 25% discount. This was considered misleading and unacceptable with a £5000 investment gaining BTC very little. It was concluded that BTC could pay for model runs as independent users, if and when required, without the £5000 outlay and without a 25% discount.
