## 683/12 Apologies for absence

Apologies were received and accepted from Cllrs Strain-Clark and Try.

# 684/12 Declarations of interest

Cllrs. Bloomfield, Smith & Whyte declared an interest as Trustees of the Old Gaol. Cllr Cadd and Cllr Smith declared and interest in the Citizens Advice Bureau. Cllrs Hirons and P Collins declared and interest in St Peter & St Paul's Church. Cllr Mordue declared and interest in The Swan Community Hub Ltd.

## 685/12 Budgets 2012/13

Councillor Harvey initially commented that as there is no Town Council plan with set priorities the budget setting process and what areas need funding is made more difficult. Furthermore that such a plan should be created to aid in future years.

The Town Clerk gave a brief introduction to his report, indicating that the most important impact was mostly due to changes in Localisation of Council Tax Support; The Council Tax base had also been decreased again from 4433.94 to 4393.25 and then to 3975.89, thus resulting in a cut of £4,942 and £50,692 respectively. Grants from Central Government via AVDC had been passed on to cover 90% of the shortfall – but these were not guaranteed in future years.

Councillors held a very thorough discussion over the budgets presented, questioning specifics on Events, Parks, Earmarked Projects, Staff costs and the Buckingham Neighbourhood Development Plan.

Members discussed whether to aim for 0% Precept increase, taking the extra from reserves, or raise the rate by up to 4%.

Proposed by Cllr. Harvey, seconded by Cllr. O'Donoghue and **AGREED** that the officer recommendations be adopted as the Town Council budget.
