- 10.2 This council asks the Town Clerk to prepare a short report on the viability of supporting the establishment of (a) 20mph zone/s within Buckingham to reduce pollution and improve road safety (among other outcomes) and recommend ways forward that the Town Council might take.
- 10.3 The council asks the Town Clerk to investigate the background to the recent referendum in Fylde Borough which requires the Council to abandon Cabinet style governance and return to a committee structure for making decisions:
