Catch the Bus

Catching the bus in Buckingham couldn't be easier with many services running from the nearby estates and villages such as Padbury, Maids Moreton and Gawcott. There are also regular services travelling further afield to towns and cities such as Oxford, Bicester, Milton Keynes, Aylesbury and Winslow.

In Winslow the Winslow and District Community bus provides services to the town and surrounding villages such as Swanbourne and Little Horwood. Operating regularly is service 50 to Newton Longville, Bletchley and Milton Keynes, and services 60/X60 which run to Aylesbury, Buckingham and Milton Keynes.

Central Milton Keynes Station is one of the nearby railway stations to Buckingham and Winslow, where passengers can catch direct trains to London, Birmingham and Manchester.

Other stations nearby include Aylesbury, Bicester Village, Bicester North, Bletchley and Wolverton.

Walking

Why Walk?

Walking is a fantastic way to stay healthy; it's easy to fit into everyday life, it's free and doesn't require any equipment other than a comfortable pair of shoes.

Health and wellbeing

Buckingham to Winslow cycle route and footway

In January 2017 a 9km shared cycle and footway connecting the towns of Buckingham and Winslow will be completed. It runs along the A413 via Padbury. This is part of the A413 Sustainable Travel Scheme which will also upgrade three existing bus stops in Buckingham with real-time passenger information and Wi-Fi accessibility.

The scheme aims to encourage more cycling, walking and bus trips to the town centres; the planned east-west rail station at Winslow as well as other local destinations along the A413 corridor.

4 stop Y2 towards Bletchley (towards Central Railway Station on return journey) up to every 10 minutes

5 6 stop YI towards Bletchley/Lakes Estate (towards Wolverton on return journey) up to every **7/8 minutes**
