379/23 Cemetery consultation and resolution

The annual loan repayments will come to around £72000. It is also intended to increase the council tax precept for the purpose of the loan repayments by 0.22% which is the equivalent of an additional £2600 a year. The required precept increase consultation has already taken place.
